GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:

1. All of the following events occurred in the District of Columbia unless otherwise noted. The following statement is presented for the sole purpose of establishing probable cause and does not represent the totality of facts and circumstances known to your affiant, Detective Brian McCarthy of the Metropolitan Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division.

2. On Friday, October 24, 2025, at approximately 8:22:09 PM, ShotSpotter, an automated system used by the Metropolitan Police Department ("MPD") for detecting gunshots in Washington, D.C., detected approximately nine (9) rounds fired in the 600 block of Howard Place NW. This particular weekend was Howard University Homecoming, and as a result, there were multiple MPD officers detailed in the immediate area when the shots were fired. Officers of the Third District were also dispatched to the scene. Detectives, including Detective Hernandez, responded to the scene and Detective Hernandez subsequently prepared an Initial Case Resume. Members of law enforcement located five victims suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. A Department of Forensic Sciences ("DFS") Crime Scene Forensic Scientist responded to the scene, took photographs, and collected evidence. Your affiant did not take part in the initial investigation.

Scene of the Shooting

3. At the scene, members of law enforcement located a suspected bullet fragment, a .40 caliber bullet, and eight (8) cartridge casings along the eastern end of the roadway within the 600 block of Howard Place NW.

4. Members of law enforcement located three handguns in the immediate area of the 600 block of Howard Place NW. One of the recovered firearms was a privately made firearm ("PMF") P80 with a Glock 17 slide (slide SN:BRCV556), 9mm handgun, with a brown or tan magazine marked to hold 31 rounds. This firearm was initially located under Victim 2 (see *infra*), but was recovered by DFS from the grass to the south of the south sidewalk in the 600 block of Howard Place NW (near the location where Victim 2 was located). The second firearm was a Smith & Wesson SD9 2.0, 9mm handgun with serial number EFK0333. This firearm was recovered at the edge of the south sidewalk in the 600 block of Howard Place NW. This firearm was observed by officers dropping from the person of Identified Person 1, after he was patted down by members of law enforcement and as he was taking flight. Identified Person 1 was subsequently apprehended and charged with possession of the SD9 9mm handgun.

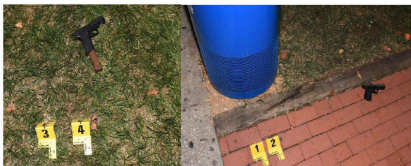


Figure 1 – Recovered PMF and Smith & Wesson Firearms

5. A third firearm, a Glock 19 9mm handgun, was located around the corner, next to a planter on the west side of the 2300 block of 6th Street NW. This firearm was recovered in the flight path of the Suspect's group.

Victim Interviews

6. Upon arriving at the scene, officers located Victim 1, a 13-year-old male who was suffering from a single gunshot wound to his left forearm, sitting on the ground. Victim 1 informed officers that he had been shot. Officers rendered aid by applying a tourniquet to Victim 1's arm, and AMR Ambulance 81 responded to the scene and transported Victim 1 to Children's National Hospital. Detective Arroyo responded to Children's National Hospital and made contact with Victim 1, who sustained what is believed to be a single gunshot wound with both entry and exit points to his left forearm.

7. Upon Detective Arroyo's arrival, Victim 1's mother was present in the hospital room. Detective Arroyo conducted an interview with Victim 1 in the presence of his mother. Victim 1 stated that he and his group had arrived at Howard University approximately 30 minutes prior to the shooting. He recalled leaving the gated area near 6th Street and Howard Place NW with his brother and two friends. As they walked westbound on Howard Place NW, they passed a group of approximately 12 individuals. According to Victim 1, most of the males in the group were dressed in black and wearing masks. Victim 1 recognized one individual in the group as "Rasheed,"

who had allegedly robbed him two years prior when Victim 1 was in sixth grade. At the time of the robbery, Rasheed was reportedly a student at Capitol Hill Montessori and now attends Phelps High School. As Victim 1 and his group passed the larger group, someone from the group reportedly said, "What's up with y'all?" Victim 1 stated that they responded, "Nothing," and continued walking westbound toward Georgia Avenue NW. Shortly thereafter, Victim 1 heard gunshots and began to run. He was struck in the left arm during the incident. Victim 1 stated that he did not see who fired the shots.

8. MPD officers located Victim 2 lying on the edge of the sidewalk, next to the street, in the 600 block of Howard Place NW, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to his legs. MPD Officer Walls immediately began to render emergency first aid to Victim 2. While rendering first aid, Victim 2 asked Officer Walls to hand him his phone, which was lying close-by where the street and curb meet. After handing Victim 2 his phone and while he is holding the device outside of Officer Walls' body-worn camera view, from audio, it sounds that Victim 2 calls his mother and begins telling her that he got shot by Howard. While tending to Victim 2, Officer Walls observed the referenced PMF P80 handgun under Victim 2's body near his waistband. Officer Walls removed the firearm from Victim 2. The pistol was loaded with one round of 9mm ammunition in the chamber and three rounds of 9mm ammunition in the 31 round extended magazine.

9. Victim 2 was placed under arrest and Victim 2's phone was seized. Victim 2, who was suffering from gunshot wounds to each of his legs, was transported by ambulance, to MedStar-Washington Hospital Center ("Medstar").

10. Detective Altieri responded to MedStar and interviewed Victim 2 in Trauma Bay #2. Victim 2 did not wish to make a statement as to what happened and how he was shot.

11. A DC Fire and Emergency Medical Services ("DCFEMS") ambulance transported Victim 3, who was suffering from a gunshot wound to his buttocks and a gunshot wound to his right calf, to MedStar. Victim 3 was interviewed in Trauma Bay #1 by Detective Altieri. Victim 3 stated that he, along with Victim 2, arrived at Howard University for the Homecoming events. Victim 3 stated that at some point, they observed another group of males dressed in dark clothing and black face masks. Victim 3 stated that the males said something to the group he was with and that something was said back. Victim 3 stated that he turned around, and that's when the gunfire erupted and he realized he was shot. Victim 3 was in stable condition.

12. Officers Garcia and Munoz were in the area of Georgia Avenue NW and Howard Place NW when they heard gunshots. The officers ran into the 600 block of Howard Place NW, where they observed Victim 4 lying tucked behind some shrubbery, yelling that she had been shot and couldn't feel her legs. Officer Munoz stated that he then found a gunshot wound on Victim 4's upper right side and that he applied a chest seal. DCFEMS Medic 2 then transported Victim 4 to Howard University Hospital.

13. Detective Nyakaana Blair found Victim 4 (Z.F.) in "Trauma 1" at Howard University Hospital being attended to by a team of medical personnel. Victim 4 was observed to be in a semi-conscious state and had a chest tube inserted. The attending doctor stated that Victim 4 had sustained a gunshot wound to her right posterior axillary line 3 interspace (right upper chest). The attending doctor advised that Victim 4 was in a stable but decreased neurological deficit with no sensation below her chest. The attending doctor reported that Victim 4 was scheduled to have a CT scan and then would be taken to the Surgical Intensive Care Unit of the hospital. The attending doctor advised that he had no further timeline for her care or release after that. Victim 4 was unable to be interviewed due to her being unconscious. Officers learned that Victim 4 was a Morgan State University student

visiting Howard for the homecoming celebration. The victim remains paralyzed from the chest down as a result of the shooting.

14. Detective Nyakaana Blair then found Victim 5 in "Trauma 2" at Howard University Hospital, who was conscious and alert. Victim 5 stated that he was in a large crowd near the "Howard main gate" when he heard the sound of gunshots. Victim 5 stated that he then began running in the 2000 block of 8th Street NW when he felt a sharp pain in his left arm. Victim 5 stated that he realized that he had been shot, so he flagged down a nearby MPD officer for assistance. Victim 5 was then transported to Howard University Hospital by DCFEMS Medic 21. A nurse advised that Victim 5 had sustained a gunshot wound to his left arm. The nurse advised that Victim 5 was in stable condition and would be observed for a limited time before discharge.

Follow-up Investigation – NIBIN Investigation Unit

15. On October 25, 2025, the case was assigned to the NIBIN Investigation Unit ("NIU") which is an ATF Task Force unit comprised of MPD detectives and ATF special agents ("SA").

16. Detectives from the initial investigation, detectives assigned to NIU, and task force SAs and TFOs performed extensive video canvassing in this case. Your affiant, a member of NIU, later assumed the role of lead investigator on this case on October 28, 2025.

Video Review

17. Surveillance video was recovered from multiple sources showing the Suspect's group during the shooting, prior to the shooting, and after the shooting. The following summary is non-exhaustive in nature and does not describe the contents of every video in the possession of law enforcement. The below map represents a summary of the video evidence, which will be explained in more detail *infra*.¹

Video Relating to the Immediate Area of the Shooting

18. Surveillance video was obtained by members of the investigative team from the Howard University surveillance camera system. The video shows the shooting and the events immediately before and after the shooting.

19. At approximately 20:19:23 hours, the Suspect's group of approximately nine (9) individuals (the Suspect and eight other individuals) is observed walking northbound on the east sidewalk in the 2400 block of Georgia Avenue NW. The group continues north into the view of another camera and then goes out of view as they head towards the corner of Georgia Avenue NW and Howard Place NW. As the nine subjects travel from one camera to the other, they are generally (but not on every individual camera) distinguishable based on clothing. In particular, as the Suspect (later identified as Kaevaghn Dudley, a black male, with a date of birth of August 6,

2008) travels onto various cameras, he appears to be wearing a Moose-Knuckles-like winter coat with black fur on the hood, dark colored pants, and white and black or white and blue sneakers. The black fur, zippers, and branding often stand out in the images, see e.g. Figure 4 and Figure 5.

20. At approximately 20:21:30 hours, what appears to be the same group of nine subjects can be seen walking eastbound into another camera in the 600 block of Howard Place NW.

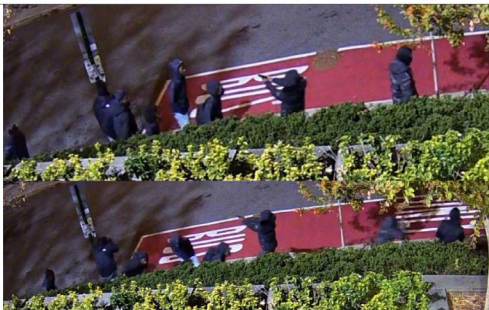


Figure 6 – Suspect pointing apparent handgun and group members ducking

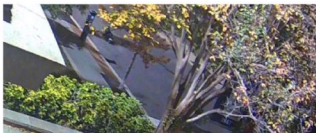


Figure 7 – Individual falling to the street

21. As the Suspect's group walks east on the south sidewalk, two groups of four subjects pass the Suspect's group of nine in the middle of the street. One group of four seems to keep walking to the west, while the other group of four appears to, at least in part, turn back towards the Suspect's group. The Suspect's group also turns back towards this latter group of four, who stand in the middle of the street. The Suspect then quickly walks away from the four subjects, deeper into his own group, and, at approximately 20:22:11 hours, turns around and appears to be holding an object consistent with a handgun, pointing in the direction of the group of four subjects. The apparent handgun can be seen erupting flashes of light consistent with gunfire. Just prior to the apparent gunfire, other members of the Suspect's group suddenly duck out of the way, as they either notice the Suspect holding a gun, or perhaps due to some exclamation from the Suspect or another person, *see Figure 6*. Another camera angle of the same area shows one of the members of the group in the street fall to the ground as the others run, *see Figure 7*.

22. After the Suspect stops firing, the Suspect's group can be seen running around the corner towards 6th Street NW and another camera shows the group jumping over a small wall/ledge on 6th Street NW, *see Figure 9*. Note that this is the same area where the aforementioned Glock 19 was recovered. None of the recovered firearms from the scene match the caliber of the .40 caliber shell casings found at the location where the shooting occurred.

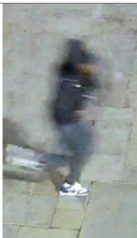


Figure 8 – Suspect running around the corner at 6th St NW and Howard Place NW

Video Relating to the Pre-Shooting Period

23. Members of the investigation team were able to recover a series of surveillance video clips, which back-tracked the movement of the Suspect's group. The following section will be explained in reverse chronological order.

the 2000 block of Georgia Avenue NW. The video appears to show, based on clothing and general appearance, a group consistent with the nine-member Suspect's group traveling on Georgia Avenue NW northbound, in the direction of the scene. The time stamp reads approximately 20:12:33 hours as the group passed by 2016 Georgia Avenue NW.

25. Members of the investigation team were able to obtain video from an establishment in the 1900 block of 8th Street NW which shows what appears to be the same nine-member Suspect's group traveling southeast bound in the 700 block of Florida Ave NW at approximately 20:11:31 hours.

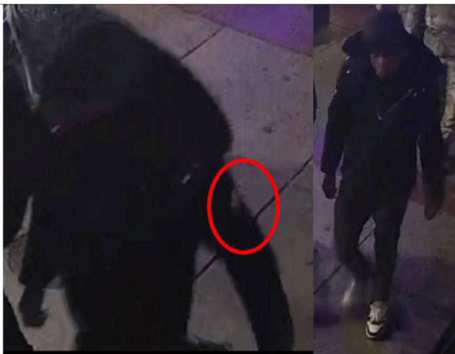


Figure 12 – Suspect's group at Vermont Ave and U Street NW; Suspect and symbol circled in red

26. Members of the investigation team were able to recover exterior surveillance camera from an establishment in the vicinity of the corner of U Street NW and Vermont Avenue NW which captured the group at 20:08:55 hours, walking east on the southern sidewalk on U Street NW in front of the business, crossing over Vermont Avenue NW, near the U Street Metro Station. Note below in *Figure 12* that the Suspect's clothing is now clearly visible in detail. The Suspect's jacket has what appears to be a Moose Knuckles symbol on the left shoulder, consistent with its overall appearance as such, and the Suspect can be seen wearing Off-White brand sneakers in the "Out Of Office" style. Your affiant is aware that this is a designer brand and that this model of shoe is currently priced at approximately \$650 MSRP on the brand's website, depending on exact model/materials.

27. Metro Transit Detective/ATF TFO Brandon Twentymon queried the surveillance system for the U Street Metro Station and was able to locate video footage of the Suspect's group exiting the U Street Metro Station at approximately 20:05:09 hours. From the footage, and in combination with other information accessible to Detective Twentymon, he was also able to identify three specific metro transit District of Columbia Public Schools ("DCPS") SmarTrip cards used by members of the Suspect's group.

28. Your affiant learned from other law enforcement that the DCPS SmarTrip cards can be issued by the District of Columbia Public School system for students to utilize the metro system to travel to school. Due to system limitations, members of the investigation team could not determine, by any manner of query, to whom these specific three SmarTrip cards were assigned.

29. Detective Twentymon was able to determine that the individuals from the Suspect's group who utilized the DCPS SmarTrip cards entered the metro transit system that night at the Rhode Island Avenue Metro Station at approximately 1945 hours on October 24, 2025. Detective Twentymon then placed all three of the DCPS SmarTrip cards in the Metro Transit active tracking list, causing the three SmarTrip cards to be flagged so that Metro Transit officers could attempt to stop and identify the holders of these SmarTrip cards if they were used in the future.

30. Footage was subsequently recovered from Metro Transit from both the U Street and Rhode Island Ave Metro Stations and it was reviewed by your affiant. What appears to be the same nine-person Suspect's group is observed in the U Street Metro Station. Note, as depicted in *Figure 13*, although the subjects are similarly dressed in mostly dark clothing, masks, hoods, jackets etc., each member of the Suspect's group has clothing which makes him distinguishable from the others. The Suspect's group arrives from Train 6045. The Suspect (fourth from the left in *Figures 13 and 14*) can be observed holding what appears to be a cell phone in his right hand and the screen is illuminated, suggesting actual usage of the device, see *Figure 13*.

First Metro Transit Police SmarTrip Card Identification and Stop

31. On October 28, 2025, one of the Suspect group's flagged DCPS SmarTrip cards was utilized. As a result of the alert, Metro Transit officers responded to the Gallery Place Metro station, 630 H Street NW, and located the user of the SmarTrip card. Metro Transit officers identified the user of the SmarTrip card as SUSPECT GROUP MEMBER 1 (hereinafter "SGM 1"). Upon being stopped by Metro Transit officers, SGM 1 asked why he was being detained. SGM 1 was told that he was a subject of a "Be on the Lookout" (BOLO). A Metro Transit officer showed SGM 1 a photo from the metro transit surveillance system at the U Street Metro Station of a subject

who utilized the SmartTrip card on October 24, 2025. At this time, SGM 1 responded "what BOLO," "is this for a shooting?" "I haven't wore this outfit for a while." SGM 1 identified himself as the individual pictured in the photograph (one of the nine-person Suspect's group), *see below Figure 16*.

Interview with MPD Tenancy Officer

32. Your affiant observed in Mark 45, MPD's records management system, that an MPD tenancy officer had stopped SGM 1 in 2025.

33. On October 29, 2025, your affiant, Detective Jolley and ATF-SA Sheeres responded to the Fifth District and met with the MPD tenancy officer. The tenancy officer was advised that the investigators thought she may possibly be able to identify any unique persons from a group of images. The tenancy officer was further advised that if she did not know any of the subjects, that was also fine. Prior to showing the images as described below, the tenancy officer was not given any indication of how or why she may know the depicted subjects.

34. The tenancy officer was handed a collection of nine still images. The images were of the Suspect and the Suspect's group. The tenancy officer reviewed all of the images and stated that she was uncertain, but two of

the depicted subjects may be students at Luke C. Moore High School. The truancy officer stated words to the effect of the following: the subjects appeared consistent with individuals who she has stopped who go to Luke C. Moore, based on clothing and general appearance, but she was uncertain. Note that neither of these subjects is the Suspect/shooter in this case. The truancy officer did not offer an identification.

Kaevaughn DUDLEY as a "Person of Interest"

35. Based on the aforementioned identification of SGM 1, members of the investigations team conducted various database queries of law enforcement and non-law enforcement databases in an attempt to identify associates, and associates-of-associates, of SGM 1.

36. On October 28, 2025, a member of the ATF investigative team observed that an associate of one of SGM 1's documented associates (this intermediate person was later identified as SGM 2) was Kaevaughn DUDLEY, a black male, with a date of birth of August 6, 2008, and PDID: DC757540 (hereinafter "DUDLEY"). This investigation team member compared mugshot photographs of DUDLEY with high-quality Metro Transit footage referenced above depicting the Suspect shooter and observed that DUDLEY appeared consistent in appearance with the Suspect shooter. DUDLEY was also of an age similar to SGM 1 and SGM 2. It was also noted that DUDLEY was stopped on January 17, 2025, wearing the same or similar black Moose Knuckles jacket with black fur on the collar. Your affiant observed that per Mark43, DUDLEY attends or attended KIPP College Preparatory, rather than Luke C. Moore as the other subjects under investigation. Your affiant also observed that the common report shared by SGM 2 and DUDLEY was more than two years old, from August 25, 2023.

Second Metro Transit Police SmarTrip Card Identification and Stop

37. On October 29, 2025, at approximately 1445 hours, Metro Transit Police initiated another stop of a group of subjects based on the relevant flagged DCPS SmarTrip cards. The stop was conducted at the Brookland-

CUA station. Your affiant, Detective Talley, and ATF SAs Shea, Murphy, Perzanoski, Donovan, Parrotte, and Ngassa all responded to the scene of the stop.

38. The investigators learned that in addition to the two individuals who were specifically stopped in reference to usage of the flagged SmartTrip cards, three additional individuals were stopped who appeared to be in the same group. The group as a whole shared similar general characteristics and clothing to the Suspect's group. For example, one of the subjects was wearing a similar (but ultimately not the same) black Moose Knuckles-like winter jacket.

39. The investigators confirmed the biographical information of each subject and compared each subject to images of the Suspect's group obtained from Metro Transit footage on the night of the shooting. The biographical information was confirmed by comparing each subject to mugshot photographs in law enforcement databases. Investigators learned that SGM 1 and SGM 2 were stopped after using the flagged SmartTrip cards. The three individuals stopped as part of the same group were SGM 3, Identified Person 2², and SGM 4. It was learned during the stop that most or all of the group attended Luke C. Moore High School.

40. Metro Transit conducted a query of SGM 2's wanted status and learned that he was wanted for a full extradition Failure to Appear warrant out of Montgomery County. SGM 2 was placed under arrest by Metro Transit and he was transported to the Juvenile Processing Center. A search of SGM 2's person incident to arrest revealed a black iPhone with damage visible to the front and back of the device (hereinafter "SGM 2's phone"). SGM 2's phone was seized as evidence as well as the DCPS SmartTrip card which he had in his possession. The serial number on the SmartTrip card was confirmed as being one of the flagged cards.

41. Your affiant and Detective Talley attempted to perform an interview of SGM 2, however SGM 2

invoked his Fifth Amendment rights and elected not to speak to the investigators.

Investigation at Luke C. Moore High School

42. On October 30, 2025, based on the statements of the MPD truancy officer, your affiant and Detective Talley responded to Luke C. Moore High School, located at 1001 Monroe St NE, Washington DC. The detectives initially met with Staff Member 1, based on the statements of the MPD truancy officer. Upon learning of the presence of police, Staff Member 2 joined the discussion as well. The detectives explained initially that they believed Staff Member 1 may possibly know the identities of individuals depicted in imagery collected during the investigation. Staff Member 1 was willing to look but sought to defer to Staff Member 2.

43. Staff Member 1 was provided with the same six images which were provided to the truancy officer the previous day. Staff Member 1 reviewed the images and pointed out one individual in particular. Staff Member 2 also reviewed the same images. Both Staff Members made statements to the effect that the individual looked familiar and may attend the school, but neither provided a name. Staff Member 2 made reference to clothes, hair and Gucci shoes. Staff Member 2 advised that he didn't actually know the name of this person off-hand. Your affiant notes that this person is not the shooter/Suspect, but merely a member of the Suspect's group.

44. Staff Member 2 began explaining that there is approximately a 70% turnover in the student body each year at Luke C. Moore. The students also have extremely poor attendance, which is what brings them to the school in the first place—because they are off-track for graduation. As a consequence, the staff at the school are perhaps less familiar with individual students' names compared with a more traditional school setting.

45. Staff Member 2 explained that when the students come in, they are logged in, they check their phones, and they are passed through weapon abatement at the door. Luke C. Moore has an electronic system which has all of the data of the check-in times.

46. Staff Member 1 and Staff Member 2 believed that Staff Member 3 would know the name of the referenced student. Staff Member 3 was shown the same image and identified the student as SGM 3, *see Figure 17*. Staff Member 3 was then allowed to review all of the images and made no additional identifications.

47. After the identification portion of the interview was concluded, the detectives asked about the five individuals (by name) who were stopped by Metro Transit on the prior day. Staff Member 2 advised that SGM 1 and SGM 2 would sometimes be together. Both Staff Member 2 and Staff Member 3 advised that none of those students were particularly involved in any trouble, other than late attendance, which is common at the school. No other new information was learned.

48. Unexpectedly, after hearing the five names, Staff Member 3 made statements to indicate he believed that the individual depicted below in *Figure 18* was SGM 2. Staff Member 3 did not attempt to match any of the other names to particular individuals in the images.

49. Your affiant obtained from the school a printout of all of the attendance logs from Monday October 20, 2025, through the day of the interview, Thursday, October 30, 2025.

Arrest of Kaevaughn Dudley on the night of October 29, 2025

50. On October 29, 2025, your affiant observed in Mark 43 on the recent arrest tab that DUDLEY had been arrested in the 1300 block of Capital Avenue NE by MPD Officer 1. Your affiant was able to discuss this new case with MPD Officer 1 via telephone the same night. MPD Officer 1 advised that he had observed an open source TikTok video featuring DUDLEY displaying a firearm in his jacket pocket in the Jay City area. MPD Officer 1 advised that ultimately when DUDLEY was stopped on October 29, he had suspected marijuana, but no firearm. MPD Officer 1 provided your affiant with photographs he took of DUDLEY on the scene as well as the aforementioned TikTok videos. MPD Officer 1 also advised that DUDLEY was charged with Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana and that the officers seized a roll of paper and placed it into evidence.

51. Your affiant reviewed the images of DUDLEY and observed that DUDLEY was wearing a black puffy jacket; however, the jacket is clearly not the same one that the suspect is wearing in the shooting surveillance.

DUDLEY is also wearing what appears to be a dark knit cap with the letters "ICEBERG," and a pair of black and red Jordan tennis shoes. See generally Figure 19. Similar to the jacket, the shoes were not the same as the shoes worn by the Suspect during the offense.

52. Your affiant asked MPD Officer 1 about his arrest, but did not show MPD Officer 1 any imagery from this shooting case during this interview.

53. Your affiant reviewed the aforementioned TikTok video. The onscreen text indicates the video was posted by the account "@kwickbanginallweek." The user's posts display the handle of "Kwickbangin6." Your affiant reviewed the account via internet browser and observed that the same video was still up as one of the posts on the account and the post was made on October 22, just two days before the shooting. 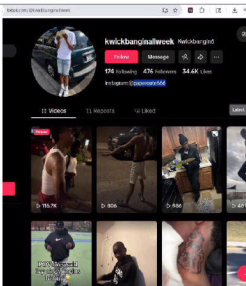


Figure 20 – kwickbanginalweek TikTok page

54. In the video, DUDLEY and others are dancing. He is wearing what appears to be the same or similar Moose Knuckles black puffy jacket as the Suspect. He is also wearing what appears to be the same "ICEBERG" knit hat and the same black and red Jordan tennis shoes as when he was arrested on October 29, 2025 (but these are not the same as what the Suspect was wearing). In the video, DUDLEY has what appears to be a semi-automatic handgun protruding from his inner left jacket pocket. The grip, bottom of the magazine, and a small part of the top of the slide is visible protruding from his inner jacket pocket, *see Figure 21*.

55. Several other subjects are also depicted, including members of the Suspect's group, including SGM 2 and SGM 3. One of the comments states the following: "Aww look at my *kk & dee* 🤔🤔🤔..." (emphasis added). A screen recording was made of the video and the comments. The nicknames "KK" and "Dee" would come up later in the investigation.

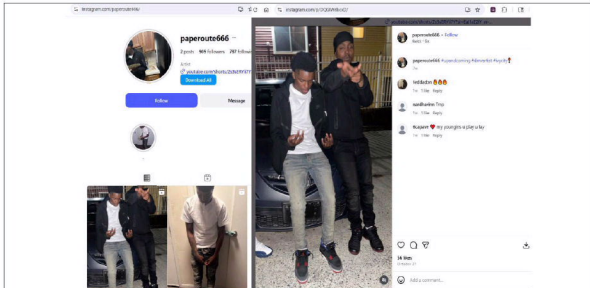


Figure 23 – Paperoute666 IG and referenced post (right)

56. The TikTok account also cites to the user's Instagram account as "@paperoute666." Your affiant reviewed the paperoute666 account and observed additional imagery of DUDLEY. Your affiant reviewed the paperoute666 account and observed additional imagery of Dudley, see *Figure 23* (left). Based on the images and posts, the account appears to be operated by DUDLEY. One image/post found on the account, shown on the right side of *Figure 23*, is of DUDLEY (left) and SGM 2 (right), posted on October 21, 2025. The posts from the account have the subtitle of "Kwick," under the paperoute666 handle, suggestive of a nickname. The Instagram account also has a link to a YouTube short, which redirects to: <https://www.youtube.com/shorts/Zs3sERYIh7Y>. Upon following this URL, the title of the video at the bottom is "Kwick – Drop Buckets." The stationary image on the screen of the YouTube short is a photograph of DUDLEY, see *Figure 24*.

Review of SGM 2's iPhone Extraction

57. On November 3, 2025, Detective Webb obtained search warrant 2025 CSWSLD 004821 to search SGM 2's iPhone. On the same date, the warrant was executed on the device by MPD's Digital Evidence Unit. Your affiant received a copy of the extraction the following day and began reviewing the data. The following collection of information revealed by the phone is non-exhaustive in nature and represents a sample of the evidence found in the phone.

58. The extraction displays the chat messages being sent from the device with the name "Dee 30 (owner)." Your affiant observed messages where other subjects are referring to the user as "Dee," which would be consistent with a nickname variant on SGM 2's first name.

59. On October 24, 2025, SGM 2's device is exchanging messages with a contact with the number Phone Number 1 labeled as "dayday666". This is consistent with the same number provided to your affiant by SGM 3. The way the contact is saved would also be consistent with a shortened nickname variant on SGM 3's first and last name.

60. On October 24, 2025, SGM 2's device is exchanging messages with a contact with the number Phone Number 2 labeled as "Harlod." This is consistent with a misspelling of SGM 1's first name. This is consistent with the same number provided to your affiant by SGM 1.

61. On October 24, 2025, at approximately 0636 hours, a contact in SGM 2's device as Email Address I sends a TikTok video link to a group chat (hereinafter the "Group Chat") of which SGM 2's phone is a member: <https://www.tiktok.com/t/ZTM9v875G/>. Your affiant visited this URL and observed that it is the same TikTok post video referenced above in paragraphs 53 through 55. Later, on October 24, 2025, in the same Group Chat, Harlod says, "Aye mari," and Email Address I responds "Yea."

63. The contact "Kwick" with that number is saved with a photograph. The individual depicted appears consistent with DUDLEY.

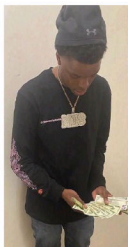


Figure 26 – Contact Photograph for Kwick

64. There is another contact saved as Kwick🤔❤️. This latter contact is associated with the email address of kaydeezee7@gmail.com. Note the similarity to DUDLEY's initials.

65. On October 26, 2024, at approximately 1310 hours, SGM 2's device has a message exchange with a contact saved as "Ma❤️". This number is believed to be associated with SGM 2's mother; see *infra*. The messages make reference to "K":

66. At approximately 1430 hours, SGM 2's device sends a message stating, "We down at Union." The affiant recognized this likely refers to Union Station.

67. At approximately 1508 hours, SGM 2's device sends a message to an unlisted number "Send 75 1025679406," followed by another message stating, "I've got my Kwick money." The unlisted number replies, "Ok. Got it."

68. A member of the ATF investigative team later conducted an open source CashApp query of this number and observed that it is connected to a CashTag of 867c388a09D6 and a name of "KWICK MONEY."

69. At approximately 1607 hours, SGM 2's phone receives a message from the contact "Ma ❤️," stating, "U still at the station?" SGM 2's phone responds "Yea." Ma ❤️ goes on to ask whether, "U get food." SGM 2's device responds, "Some McDonald." Your affiant is aware that there is a McDonald's in Union Station.

70. At approximately 1623 hours, SGM 2's phone makes a call to SGM 1's number.

71. At approximately 1637 hours, the number Phone Number 2, which is saved as "Jr," sends a message to SGM 2's phone in another group chat, of which SGM 2 and "Kwick," are members, with a TikTok link: <https://www.tiktok.com/t/ZP8AoNnoC/>. The link leads to a video at this URL: <https://www.tiktok.com/@stackjoel/video/7564606115732802830>, see below still image from the video. The video depicts three men saluting, with the caption: "Me preparing da men for Howard homecoming tmr."

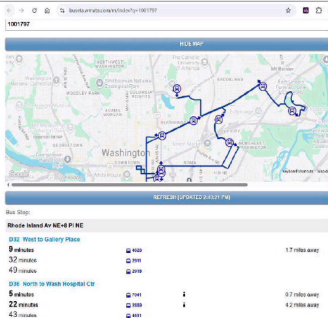


Figure 30 – WMATA bus map

73. At approximately 1713 hours, a contact saved in SGM 2's device asks "Wya [sic]" which your affiant recognizes as commonly meaning "Where you at?" SGM 2's device replies "Union."

74. At approximately 1723 hours, dayday666 asks, "Fya," which your affiant recognizes as commonly meaning "F**k you at?" SGM 2's device replies McDonald's. dayday666 replies, "Rd," and then SGM 2's device replies, "We at the bottom now." Your affiant is aware that the bottom of Union Station could refer to the food court area.

75. At approximately 1736 hours, "Harlod" asks the Group Chat, "Yall still at union." SGM 2's device replies, "Yea." Harlod replies that he is on the way.

76. The following conversation occurs in the Group Chat:

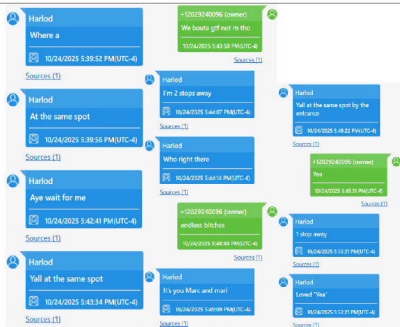


Figure 31 – Group Chat conversation

77. At approximately 1827 hours, SGM 2's device visits the same or similar bus information page referenced above. At approximately 1828 hours, dayday666 asks, "Wya." And SGM 2's phone replies "On the way."

78. Immediately after the shooting occurs, SGM 2's device is used in a series of calls; most which are with Ma ❤️, which sometimes displays with the name (truncated version of SGM 2's mom name)³.

79. At approximately 2117 and 2127 hours, Harlod sends the below images to the Group Chat. The image on the left seems to refer to the Howard Homecoming shooting, but the image on the right seems to refer to an unrelated shooting in Southeast.

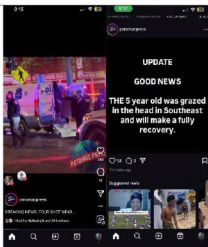


Figure 32 – potomacpress IG posts

81. On October 25, 2025, at approximately 1822 hours, a saved contact sends SGM 2's phone a link to a TikTok video: <https://www.tiktok.com/t/ZP8DJBa4R/>. Your affiant followed this URL which leads to the URL: <https://www.tiktok.com/@lilzayhavim/video/7565213706473295118>. Your affiant observed that it appears to be a video of the Suspect, SGM 2 and another individual dancing (TikTok Associate 1 (or "TKA 1")). TKA 1 is wearing a similar Moose Knuckles jacket to the Suspect, but his shoes and pants are different and the two are clearly distinguishable. Surveillance of the shooting also shows the shooter wearing what appears to be a white or light-colored undershirt, which is consistent with DUDLEY's appearance, *see Figure 34*. In addition, when

reviewing imagery of the nine-member group from the Rhode Island and U Street Metro Stations, investigators did not find anyone matching TKA 1's appearance traveling with the Suspect's group to the scene of the shooting.

82. Your affiant recognized that the video appeared to have been shot in the Union Station food court area. In furtherance of this idea, the video also has #union tagged on the bottom. The TikTok was posted on an account called "lilzayhavinn" and was dated on October 25. Given the temporal proximity between the posting date and the date of the shooting, and the fact that the Suspect and SGM 2 appeared to be wearing the same or extremely similar clothing as in the shooting and pre-shooting footage, it seemed plausible that it may have been filmed on the date of the shooting. Due to this being a TikTok video, likely filmed with a cellphone camera, the video has clear imagery of the Suspect, *see below e.g. compared with a surveillance still.*

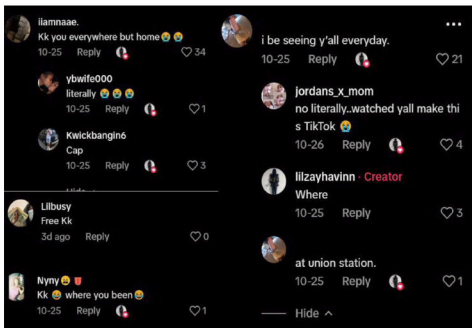


Figure 35 – TikTok video comments

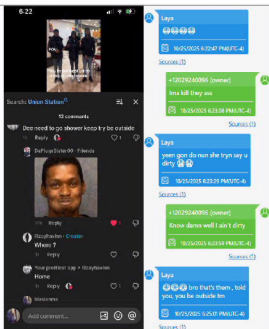


Figure 36 – TikTok comments about Dee with follow-up conversation

85. On October 28, 2025, at approximately 2233 hours, Harlod sends an audio message mentioning that the police detained him while talking about a BOLO. He goes on to say that he thinks it's about that "shit that happened at what's it name, but n**** I had on a whole different outfit." He exclaims what the f***?

86. In the moments leading up to SGM 2's arrest on October 29, 2025, SGM 2's device had multiple video calls to and from "Kwick."

Interviews with Fifth District Crime Suppression Team members on November 5, 2025

87. On November 5, 2025, your affiant and Detective Talley responded to the Fifth District station. The detectives initially spoke with MPD Officer 2, a member of the Fifth District Crime Suppression Team ("CST"). The conversation occurred privately, away from other members of his unit. The detectives advised that they would like to show some images to MPD Officer 2 and see if he happens to recognize the subjects depicted. MPD Officer 2 asked which section of the city the detectives thought the subject might frequent and he was advised that they might frequent Ivy City. MPD Officer 2 reviewed the images and did not know the identity of the subjects. MPD Officer 2 went on to advise that MPD Officer 1 had recently arrested a subject in the 1900 block of Capitol Ave NE, but that MPD Officer 2 was not on the scene. MPD Officer 2 advised that he believed that MPD Officer 1 might know the subjects, but that MPD Officer 1 was out on the street and he would be returning soon.

88. After MPD Officer 1 returned to the station from conducting street enforcement activities, your affiant and Detective Talley met with MPD Officer 1 privately, away from other members of his unit. Detective

2025. As a consequence, your affiant learned that MPD Officer 1 came into prolonged close contact with DUDLEY twice between October 28 and November 5. MPD Officer 1 further advised that he took photographs of DUDLEY on the stop. He then showed the detectives the photos and subsequently sent copies of the photos your affiant. Your affiant observed that DUDLEY appears to be wearing the same or extremely similar Moose Knuckles puffy black jacket with black fur and also he is wearing what appears to be the same hat as when he was arrested on October 29th.

90. MPD Officer 1 advised Detective Talley that he has observed DUDLEY on social media, in a video with a firearm, around the basketball court located in the 1900 block of Gallaudet Street NE. MPD Officer 1 advised that this was the same TikTok video which he sent to your affiant, when your affiant spoke to MPD Officer 1 on the night of October 29, 2025, which is the night of DUDLEY's arrest. MPD Officer 1 advised that the subject

is known by him to frequent the Ivy City area and that MPD Officer 1 sees him often. He also recalled specifically that he observed him on a stop in the 1800 block of Kendall Street NE on September 10, 2025 (he found the date based on additional photographs he took), but he was unsure as to whether DUDLEY would've been captured on his body-worn camera because he did not stop him. He recalled that he contacted the same heavy-set male from the referenced TikTok video (not DUDLEY) and that there were also two females present. MPD Officer 1 also showed your affiant that he took photographs of that event and the time stamp was September 10, 2025, at approximately 2226 hours.

91. MPD Officer 1 advised that he located DUDLEY's (based on the contents of the postings) TikTok @kwickbanginalweek by open source TikTok exploration.

92. MPD Officer 1 was not informed of the significance, if any, of his identification. The detectives concluded the discussion with MPD Officer 1 and next met with MPD Officer 3 privately. MPD Officer 3 was unaware of the contents of the preceding interview with MPD Officer 1.

93. Your affiant showed MPD Officer 3 the same image in *Figure 38* – TikTok still and MPD Officer 3 stated, "Oh, that's my man, I just stopped on Central." MPD Officer 3 specifically pointed at the subject on the right side of the image (DUDLEY). He went on to describe that the subject didn't want to identify himself on the stop. MPD Officer 3 advised that he observed the subject on TikTok with a gun and has seen the subject around the Ivy City area. He noted that he has also seen the subject on the left as well, but he was uncertain of his identity. MPD Officer 3 advised that as to the figure on the right, he was referring to the same individual arrested by MPD Officer 1 last week and he offered to show the detectives the body-worn camera footage of the stop.

94. MPD Officer 3 showed the detectives a video from October 28, 2025, which is four days after the shooting under investigation, carrying ID a3446be69cf84018b40a84cd91c1e781. The video is tagged as a contact

at Capital and Central. The GPS data for the file indicates that it is in the 1800 block of Central Place NE, near that intersection. This stop is consistent with the one described by MPD Officer 1 in the prior interview and the photos which MPD Officer 1 provided.

95. MPD Officer 3 played his body-worn camera video and pointed out the right side individual in the attached still image, indicating that this was the subject to which he referred earlier in the interview. Your affiant observed in the body-worn camera that the individual shown by MPD Officer 3 in the body-worn camera footage is one and the same as DUDLEY and as noted above in MPD Officer 1's photographs, DUDLEY is wearing what appears to be the same black or extremely similar black Moose Knuckles jacket with black fur which the Suspect in this case is seen wearing. DUDLEY is holding and appearing to operate a phone in a black case in his left hand. At times, he appears to be possibly filming the stop based on the way he is pointing the device and the fact that the flashlight is illuminated. DUDLEY is wearing the same or extremely similar ICEBERG hat which he can be observed wearing in images in SGM 2's phone (*see supra*). At least one other member of the Suspect group, SGM 3, is also observed on the scene with DUDLEY. MPD Officer 1 is also on the scene of the stop (amongst other law enforcement).

Identification by MPD Officer 4

96. On November 6, 2025, your affiant and Detective Talley responded to KIPP DC College Preparatory, located at 1405 Brentwood Parkway NE with intent to speak to school administrators. Prior to entering, the detectives spoke with a school resource officer with MPD, to attempt to find out who at the school would be a good person to speak to first to assist in the investigation. The school resource officer advised that in her experience, the staff at the school tended to be uncooperative in police investigations, and that they would likely demand legal process. The school resource officer, however, advised that there were MPD officers who regularly worked part-

time security at the school, while off-duty. The school resource officer put the detectives in contact with MPD Officer 4, one of these officers.

97. At approximately 1413 hours, your affiant and Detective Talley interviewed MPD Officer 4 via a speaker phone call. Prior to asking about the school staff, MPD Officer 4 was asked about whether he thought he would possibly be able to recognize students from KIPP if he was shown an image of a possible student, to which MPD Officer 4 advised he likely could recognize a student of the school if shown such an image.

98. At approximately 1417 hours, while still on the phone with MPD Officer 4, Detective Talley sent the still image in *Figure 38* – TikTok still, depicting the Suspect and another individual from a TikTok video which was taken on October 24, 2025. MPD Officer 4 first asked which of the two individuals the detectives were trying to identify. MPD Officer 4 was asked if he recognized either of the individuals in the images. MPD Officer 4 advised that he immediately recognized the individual on the right because he is a student at KIPP and they banter with each other on a daily basis at KIPP. MPD Officer 4 further advised that he has a GPS device on his ankle. MPD Officer 4 provided the name of the subject as “Kaevaughn DUDLEY” and he stated that DUDLEY’s nickname is “KK.”

99. MPD Officer 4 went on to make numerous additional statements regarding DUDLEY. He was aware that DUDLEY was previously on a GPS device and then came off, and then recently got put again on a GPS device.⁴ MPD Officer 4 stated that on the day prior to the interview (November 5, 2025), he had just joked with DUDLEY about DUDLEY being back on a GPS device. MPD Officer 4 advised that he knows that DUDLEY is now in a group home and gets picked up from the school around 1515 hours by the staff.

100. MPD Officer 4 advised that DUDLEY routinely attends school and is not habitually tardy. MPD

Officer 4 advised that DUDLEY is known to carry guns and that DUDLEY claims himself to be a rap artist. He recounted one instance where DUDLEY once played MPD Officer 4 one of his rap songs.

101. MPD Officer 4 typically works at KIPP as his off-duty part-time job approximately five days per week, but at a minimum of three days per week. MPD Officer 4 stated that he sees and speaks with DUDLEY every day at school. When asked how long of a period has this been going on, he advised that this is going on the second year of that pattern. MPD Officer 4 advised that DUDLEY calls MPD Officer 4 "peanut head." MPD Officer 4 also advised that DUDLEY wears the same Moose Knuckle jacket depicted in the image pretty much every day to school.

Amtrak Video from Union Station

102. On November 05, 2025, Detective Webb and ATF SA Shea traveled to Amtrak Police Department and met with an Amtrak Police investigator. The investigator was able to provide surveillance camera footage from Union Station on October 24, 2025, which included footage of the Suspect/shooter and at least some members of the Suspect's group at Union Station on October 24, 2025.

103. In specific, the investigators were able to locate footage of the aforementioned Union Station food court TikTok video being shot (paragraph 81 et seq.). In each of the below images from that surveillance, the person filming with a cell phone can be observed on the ride side. The subjects in the background match those in the TikTok video. The video was shot on October 24, 2025, at and around 1727 to 1729 hours.

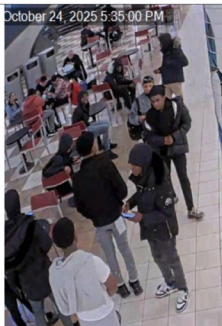


Figure 41 – Suspect using his cell phone with screen illuminated

Metro Bus Footage

105. On November 11, 2025, your affiant received metro bus video footage from Metro Bus #4655. The footage shows that on October 24, 2025, at approximately 19:36:45 hours, the Suspect's group boarded Metro Bus #4655 at Mount Olivet Road and Corcoran Street NE. The Suspect is observed utilizing a cell phone. The group is the same nine-member group as was observed at the Rhode Island Avenue Metro Station and the U Street Metro Station, as described *supra*. TKA 1 is not present amongst the nine-member group.
